





The corner sofas can be set up with each other in different versions, e.g. as a single element with a table only, combined into a right or left corner lounge set, or set together in a straight line creating a large sofa bed.

The cushions are available in 15 trendy colours and have covers with zippers, removable for washing. The high quality acrylic fabric is resistant to UV rays.

ORIGINS OF WINTER GARDENS

It is difficult to say the exact period of appearance and construction of winter gardens and greenhouses. It is known, that already in Ancient Rome houses' atriums were decorated with flowering plant in hanging pots, and for cultivation of vegetables and exotic plants Romans built hothouses. In northern countries of the European continent cultivation of heat-loving plants was impossible in open ground conditions. The origin of a modern winter garden dates back to the 17th to 19th centuries where European nobility would construct large conservatories that would house tropical and subtropical plants and would act as an extension of their living space. Many of these would be attached to their main palaces. Earlier versions would be constructed of masonry with large windows and a glass roof. usually in the Classical or Gothic styles. While in the 19th century many of these conservatories were made out of iron and curvilinear glass. Nowadays a winter garden is usually a part of a living room where plants will serve as living decoration all winter and furnishing of this place is treated with the same great care as interior decoration of the rest of the house.






MALIBU


All cushions covers of acrylic are easy to unzip for washing. The matching coffee table is square 70x70 and two tables can be set together to make one bigger table.

Robinia pseudoacacia, commonly known as the Black Locust


Robinia tree was introduced at the beginning of the 17th century to Europe. The original home was the North American East. Today it is found in the middle and South of Europe.

Robinia is a compact wood, one of the heaviest of all wood in Europe, much harder than oak. Accordingly the wood is very hard and at the same time it is also very tough combined with a high elasticity. Robinia is naturally resistant to decay and it is the only European wood that is in resistance class 1.

Because of its good material qualities it can be used in many ways. In the past it was used many times as fencing poles.

With increasing industrialization a new interest was found in the economic viability of the tree. It can be used in situations where high mechanical demands and extreme environment conditions come together, for example for excavation of the ground and waterways construction e.g. watermills, canals, shipbuilding, docks, bridges, barrels, mineshaft, etc. Beside its hardness, resistance and elasticity, robinia wood is also very decorative what makes it handsome and valuable material for production of outdoor furniture.

What is so special about the materials that GARDEN uses?

All the wood used in the manufacture of our furniture is sourced from Europe. The features are a straight grain structure, the absence of knots, splits or cracks and an even overall colour.

What's so special about the way H GARDEN makes its furniture?

H-GARDEN attention to detail is second to none. The easiest way to describe our attitude to design and finish is indoor production and quality standards combined with outdoor engineering and durability. All furniture is sanded with extra fine grades of sand paper to achieve a silky-smooth finish and we finish the underside of our furniture (i.e. the side that is never seen) to the same high standard as the top.

How easy is H GARDEN furniture to assemble?

Most pieces of furniture are supplied either fully assembled or flat-packed in sub -assemblies to minimize the amount of final assembly required. All flat-packed items come complete with a pack of fittings and detailed, multi-lingual assembly instructions. Due to thoughtful design and the accuracy of our construction no glue is required when assembling the products, only the dowels and/or bolts supplied in the fittings pack. In most cases, a single person with only a minimum of tools can assemble the furniture with in a few minutes.

Can my furniture be kept outside all vear round?

all 12 months of the year. Of course, furniture left outside all year will get more dirty than furniture that is just used in the summer. but the long-term performance and durability of the furniture is exactly the same. In order for the furniture to sustain its original appearance, it is advisable to keep it in a shady area or place a protective furniture cover over it. If you want to store your furniture over the winter, we advise that you do so in a garden shed or garage. Do not move the furniture from the garden straight into a heated indoor room for storage, as the sharp differences in temperature and humidity may cause the wood to split.

How much maintenance will my furniture require?

Robinia does not require any special maintenance routine apart from occasional cleaning. If left to age naturally outside by being exposed to light, air and rain, then the surface of the wood will gradually change to a soft, silver-grey as the pigments in the surface laver of the wood start to fade away. We recommend that you simply allow your furniture to weather naturally this way and maintain the silver patina with regular, gentle cleaning with soft-soap flakes dissolved in warm water (not detergent). However, if a regular cleaning regime is neglected, furniture can become badly weathered (grey-black in colour) or extremely dirty, in which case we recommend a cleaner and brighter designed to help restore the surface colour of the wood (available in DIY stores). In order to maintain original condition of furniture for as long as possible it is advised to place it under a roof or to use suitable furniture covers.

NESTING TABLES

This set of three matching tables, each of a descending size, which each fit inside another will take up less space and can be used as a piece of occasional furniture out in the garden or patio or in any room of the house. They can be stored in their stacked position until needed. Due to their flexibility of use TRIO nesting tables crafted of solid robinia wood are a must-have item of furniture in the house - they can be placed next to an armchair to set a drink or as a television dinner table, they can be used individually as side tables within one room or split up for use around the house in different places.

Besides their practical use, TRIO nesting tables are also an interesting decor addition. There are a lot of options for decorating with TRIO nesting tables, for example placing the tables against the wall lined up from the largest to the smallest and placing a matching lamp, a vase, photos, books or other accessories on the largest table, leaving the lower tables "nested" until needed. You can also keep your nesting tables semi-nested, simply do not fully extend them from one another, but leave them sticking out enough to place small decorative objects on them. An advantage of nesting tables is that it is easy to change the layout and decor of an area just by moving them around.







To achieve maximum enjoyment from your cushions you should care for them correctly. H-GARDEN cushions that fit into dining chairs, benches, lounge chairs, ottomans, sofas, and chaise lounges are offered with covers closed with zippers for easy removal for washing. The cushions should be cleaned regularly to prevent excessive dirt from accumulating. Simply brush off any loose dirt and clean the covers using a mild liquid detergent in lukewarm water (not exceeding 40° C). Rinse thoroughly to remove excess soap and air dry. Machine washable. Tumble drying at low heat only. If necessary, reapply a water repellent treatment after washing.

H-GARDEN cushions are not completely waterproof, so avoid exposure to extended rainfall. If cushions do become wet, separate the cushion filling from the cover and allow both to dry thoroughly. When not in use, take care to store cushions in a dry environment. Do not store cushions when wet.

Forests provide us with fresh air, food, clean water, medicine and important natural matrials, such as timber and paper. They even play an important role in preventing global warming. If managed responsibly, forests can benefit forest people and the global community. However, in some countries a huge amount of timber is harvested illegally what causes enormous damage to forests and local communities and often involves violation of human rights. Using robinia for production protects our natural environment and saves its natural resources.





No one knows exactly where the word spa comes from, but there are two main theories. One is that spa is an acronym for the Latin phrase, "salus per aquae", or "health through water". Others believe the origin of the word "spa" comes from the Belgian town of Spa, known since Roman times for its baths. They speculate that the town was so prominent that the very word spa became synonymous in the English language with a place to be restored and pampered. Modern spas have their roots in ancient towns famed for the healing powers of their mineral waters and hot springs. Travellers would come to "take the waters" and restore their health. The practice of bathing in hot springs and mineral waters dates at least to the Babylonians and Greeks, and knowing people, probably much sooner! As evidence of the importance given to the therapeutic properties of water, during the Roman Empire great thermal buildings had been built and become a real social institution. In a few times, spa centres became also an occasion for meeting and cultural exchanges. In that period, the beneficial concept of baths turned into a true therapeutic practice prescribed by the doctors in order to guarantee a longer and healthier life to their patients.

After the fall of the Roman Empire the splendour of "thermal culture" faded away because of the Barbaric invasions and the success of the Christian culture which did not accepted nudity nor promiscuity. When, in the Middle Ages, herbs and potions could not heal disease nor relieve pain, people had nothing to do but entrust the healing and purifying action of water, which gained again its lost therapeutic importance. Several kinds of water were classified, according to their composition and the single healing properties. During the Renaissance the discovery of printing improved the divulgation of information and consequently the use of hydro-treatments increased, even if the methods remained the medieval ones.


Starting from the XVIII century the development of medicine facilitated the analysis on water composition and guaranteed a scientific approach to therapies. Between the XIX and the XX centuries the fruition of spas was reserved to the privileged social class and only later this phenomenon extended to other classes too. Since the late 20th century the spa has increasingly focused on prevention, healthy lifestyles, fitness, spirituality and relaxation. With record numbers of people turning to the spa for some of their most important lifestyle pursuits, today's spa experience covers medical and spiritual programs to outdoor adventures and exotic travel. Recently spa-going has been described as a new cultural trend.

The spa aesthetic meanwhile, has broken out of the spa and into popular culture, influencing everything from fashion and cosmetics, to architecture, home décor, and cuisine.
